



Summer Teacher Residency: Summer 2021 Graduate Credit Information + Assignment

Summer Teacher Residency participants may receive up to 3 graduate workshop credit by completing an additional registration through Ursuline College and completing an additional assignment. The cost to register for the graduate workshop credit is \$140, and students who complete the assignment will receive a pass/fail grade on an official transcript.

To receive a graduate workshop credit, teachers must complete the full Summer Teacher Residency and submit a reflection essay.

Reflection Essay

Please reflect on your participation in the Residency in a 2-3 page (double-spaced) essay. Consider your expectations or goals for participation, the content and relative success of your completed work, and how your experiences in the Residency may influence you as an educator and in your personal practice.

Submitting your Work

Final copies of your assignment are due by **Monday, August 2, 2021** and must be turned in via email to ce@cia.edu. Ursuline College faculty will receive and grade the reflection and will assign a grade of pass or fail, and teachers will receive a transcript with their grade approximately four weeks after the submission deadline.
