Move-in and Orientation Notes

- CIA is located at 11610 Euclid Ave, Cleveland OH 44106
 - The Residence Hall is located at 11421 Euclid Ave, Cleveland OH 44106
- Residential students will have a designated check in time for moving in. A link for students to reserve their check-in time will be emailed in May.
 - During move-in, cars will check-in at the Annex parking lot directly behind CIA.
 - At this time, students will receive their ID key card.
 - Once checked in, you may drive over to the Residence Hall to move in. If you arrive earlier than your designated move-in timeslot, you may be asked to wait in the Annex Lot until it is your time to move in.
 - Students will unload their belongings at the Residence Hall. Staff and resident hall assistants will be onsite to assist as needed and direct you to your room. Once move-in is complete, you may park your car back in the CIA Annex parking lot. Parents/guardians should depart campus by 2pm.
- Commuter students can arrive any time between 12pm and 1:30pm, and will only need to check in at the Annex Lot behind CIA to retrieve your ID key card and Pre-College binder.

- A mandatory Welcome Session + Orientation begins at 2:30pm in the Peter B. Lewis auditorium in CIA's academic building. All residential and commuter students are required to attend.
- Following the orientation session, class breakout sessions will take place in the CIA building in your designated classroom space. Classroom locations will be noted in your Pre-College binder.
- Commuter students are welcome to depart any time after 4pm, but are encouraged to stay for dinner and group activities. Commuter students are required to depart at 8pm. Residential students are required to check into the Residence Hall by 8pm.
