Check-Out Notes

- From 9am to 4pm students will be in class critiquing and installing artwork for the exhibition. Parents/guardians must arrive no earlier than 4pm, as this is still required class time.
- During the Recognition Award Ceremony, we'll recognize faculty-nominated students for outstanding achievements during the program and announce scholarships from our Admissions Department. All students are encouraged to attend the ceremony.
- Immediately following the Recognition Award Ceremony, we invite all students, family, and friends to view the exhibition of work created during the Pre-College program. The exhibition will be on display from 5-7pm.
- From 7-8pm, students will take down their own work from the exhibition, and package it for travel if necessary. Boxes and packing material will be provided. Work must not be taken down from the exhibition until 7pm.
- Residential students must move out of the Residence Hall by 10pm. Residential students must complete a check-out form found in the Residence Hall lobby and return their ID card in the outgoing mailbox in the residence hall. Check-out is completed when the student's room has been cleaned, they've completed a check-out form, and have returned their key card. An improper check-out fee will be issued if any of these steps are missed.
- Commuter students do not need to complete a check-out form, but do need to return their ID card to a staff member or the Continuing Education office (room 118) before leaving. Students will be charged if they do not return their ID card.
