## **Pre-College: What to Bring**

This list is designed to assist you in planning for your stay in the residence hall. Supplies for classes are provided by CIA – you do not need to purchase any materials for class or studio. Here are some items you will want to bring for your two-week stay in the residence hall:

## Required:

- 1. \_\_\_\_ Cell phone and charger
- 2. \_\_\_\_ Bedding: Extra-long (XL) twin sized bed sheets, blankets, pillow
- 3. \_\_\_\_\_ Linens: towels, washcloths, hand towels
- 4. \_\_\_\_ Personal care + toiletry items: soap, shampoo, lotion, razor, hairdryer, comb, sunscreen, etc.
- 5. \_\_\_\_ Personal first aid kit: aspirin, band-aids, cold & allergy supplies, etc.
- 6. \_\_\_\_ Medications: prescription or over the counter will need to be managed by student
- 7. \_\_\_\_ Umbrella or rain coat
- 8. \_\_\_\_ Backpack
- 9. \_\_\_\_ Closet hangers
- 10. \_\_\_\_ Comfortable, closed toe footwear: tennis shoes, sneakers, Doc Martens, etc.

## **Optional:**

- 11. \_\_\_\_ Hat
- 12. \_\_\_\_ Laptop
- 13. \_\_\_\_ Snacks
- 14. \_\_\_\_\_ Headphones
- 15. \_\_\_\_ Power strip: if more than 2 electronic devices are needed in one area, no extension cords.
- 16. **Camera:** for personal use (Photography students are strongly recommended to bring their own SLR camera with video functions)
