

PRE-COLLEGE STUDENT CERTIFICATION OF FINANCES TO ENABLE ISSUANCE OF FORM I-20 TO APPLY FOR AN F-1 STUDENT VISA

To obtain the Form I-20, which allows the student to apply for an F-1 student visa to attend the Pre-College program, the US government requires CIA to obtain documentation that shows that the student has the funding necessary to attend the program including tuition, housing, food, and personal expenses. This documentation should consist of an <u>original bank statement that shows that these funds are available, verified by the bank where the funds are held</u>. This documentation must be submitted before the Form I-20 can be issued. During the visa interview, the US Consulate will also require a bank statement.

The resources required for the 2018 Pre-College program, including the program costs and an estimate of personal spending are:

• \$ 2,600 for the two week program OR • \$ 5,250 for the four week program
