Move-in and Orientation Notes

- CIA is located at 11610 Euclid Ave, Cleveland OH 44106
 - The Residence Hall is located at 11421 Euclid Ave, Cleveland OH 44106
- Residential students will have a designated check in time for moving in.
 - Cars will check-in at the Annex parking lot directly behind CIA. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, only **one** parent/guardian can accompany the student into the residence hall.
 - During check-in, students will receive their ID key card. Both the student and companion will be required to answer a series of Covid-19 pre-assessment questions when the student checks in, and will be given a wristband that will allow them to enter and exit the residence hall building for move in. No other guests will be permitted into the residence hall. Masks or face coverings are mandatory.
 - Once checked in, you may drive over to the Residence Hall to move in.

- Students will unload their belongings at the Residence Hall. Staff and resident hall RAs will be on site to assist as needed and direct you to your room. Once move-in is complete, you may park your car back in the CIA Annex parking lot. Parents/guardians should depart campus by 2pm.
- Commuter students can arrive any time between 12pm and 1:30pm, and will only need to check in at the Annex Lot behind CIA. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, only one parent/guardian can accompany the student on campus. During check-in, commuter students will receive their ID key card and binder with helpful information. Both the student and companion will need to complete a Covid-19 assessment questionnaire before receiving a wristband to access the main building on campus.
- A mandatory virtual orientation officially begins at 2pm. A link to the virtual orientation will be sent out prior to the date. All students are required to watch; parents/guardians are strongly encouraged to watch. Residential students can watch in their rooms via laptops or cell phones. Commuter students can watch in the main building's Atrium via laptops or cell phones.
- Class breakout sessions will take place in-person in the CIA building. When entering the building, students must complete a temperature check, and masks or face coverings are required.
- An optional drop-in Q&A session will be held via Zoom from 4-5pm for anyone with remaining questions.
- Commuter students are welcome to depart any time after 4pm, but are encouraged to stay for dinner and group activities. Commuter students are required to depart at 8pm. Residential students are required to check into the Residence Hall by 10pm.
