Check-Out Notes

- From 9am to 4pm students will be in class critiquing and setting up for the exhibition. Parents/guardians must arrive no earlier than 4pm, as this is still required studio time. Parking will be available in the Annex Lot and Lot 73.
- During the virtual Scholarship Award Ceremony, the Admissions department will award CIA scholarships to select Pre College students to be used towards full time enrollment at CIA's undergraduate program. All students and parents are encouraged to view the ceremony.
- Over the following week we will be collecting digital submissions for the Pre-College Virtual Exhibition. More info will be shared with students during the program.
- Residential students must reserve a move-out time slot between 5-9:30pm that Friday. Similar to move-in, only one parent/guardian will be allowed in the Residence Hall to assist with move-out and they must comply with all Covid-19 health and safety measures. Residential students must also complete a check-out form found in the Residence Hall lobby. ID cards can be returned at the end of the day after the students have moved out, and should be placed in the outgoing mailbox in the residence hall.
